Welcome to 2nd Grade! Here are all of the materials that your student will need in order to be successful in second grade. I will do my best to explain the purpose of any materials that are vague to help make sure the right items are brought to class, but if you have any questions, ask me on parentsquare!

Materials for Pencil Box: Second graders desks open from the top, so a pencil box will be extremely important. These boxes should be able to fit all of the materials below. Please pack these boxes before school begins, keeping extra materials at home for resupply as needed, or donated to the class.) Sharpened pencils (3-6) Sharpener (with catch for pencil shavings) Eraser (1) Glue stick (1-2) Dry erase marker (1) Scissors (1)
Materials for Desk: Know your student and what they will be successful with. For
example, I've seen students with 128 packs of crayons that spill each time they are used, but I've also seen students with specialty markers that are kept organized all year. The number I included is the minimum to be successful in class. 12-24 count box of crayons
